DISCUSSION QUESTIONS  
ARIZONA'S VULNERABLE POPULATIONS

1. Many of us either belong to or know someone who is a member of a vulnerable population. To what extent is it important for us to consider their needs? To what extent do members of vulnerable populations have unique assets or perspectives that they can provide to the community?
2. What are the best ways to support vulnerable populations that promote resiliency? Consider:
  - a. Educational opportunities;
  - b. Employment opportunities;
  - c. Access to health care, including behavioral/mental health care;
  - d. Actions or programs that create stronger more resilient families and neighborhoods.
  - e. Access to banking and financial institutions.
  - f. Personal and emotional support.
3. If you could tell Arizona's elected leaders one thing about Arizona's vulnerable populations, what would you tell them or ask them to do?
4. What one action will you commit to as a result of this Future Leaders Town Hall? Consider talking about the issue of vulnerable populations with others, becoming more engaged in policy issues in general, taking action to assist vulnerable populations or any other idea that comes to mind.
