2. What are Arizona's unique natural resources and strengths when it comes to water systems? What are our greatest challenges? Consider population trends, the environment, the control of water systems through dams and other structures and the impact of an extended drought in the Southwest.

3. What are the best ways to support a sustainable water system for Arizona? Consider conservation efforts by individuals, businesses and organizations, technological advances such as the desalinization of salt water, changes in how water is used or regulated or other ideas.

4. If you could tell Arizona's elected leaders one thing about water in Arizona, what would you tell them or ask them to do?

5. What one action will you commit to as a result of this Town Hall? Consider talking about the issue of water with others, becoming more engaged in policy issues, taking action to support conservation of water or any other ideas that comes to mind.
